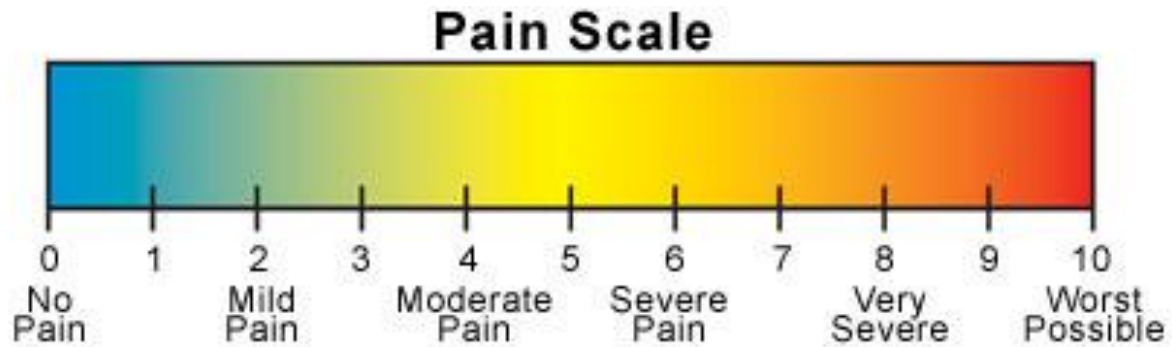


## Pain Scales:



## The Pain Assessment in Advanced Dementia Scale (PAINAD)

<b>BREATHING</b>	<b>0</b> Normal	<b>1</b> Labored	<b>2</b> Noisy/labored	<b>Score:</b>
<b>NEGATIVE VOCALIZATION</b>	<b>0</b> None	<b>1</b> Occasional moans/muttering	<b>2</b> Repeated troubled calling out /loud moaning or crying	<b>Score:</b>
<b>FACIAL EXPRESSION</b>	<b>0</b> Smiling or inexpressive	<b>1</b> Sad, frown	<b>2</b> facial grimacing	<b>Score:</b>
<b>BODY LANGUAGE</b>	<b>0</b> Relaxed	<b>1</b> Tense and pacing	<b>2</b> Rigid with fists clenched, or striking out	<b>Score:</b>
<b>CONSOLABILITY</b>	<b>0</b> no need to console	<b>1</b> distracted or reassured	<b>2</b> unable to distract or console	<b>Score:</b> <b>/10</b>
